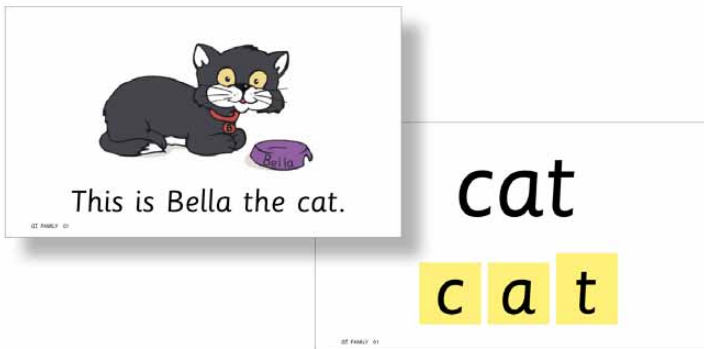
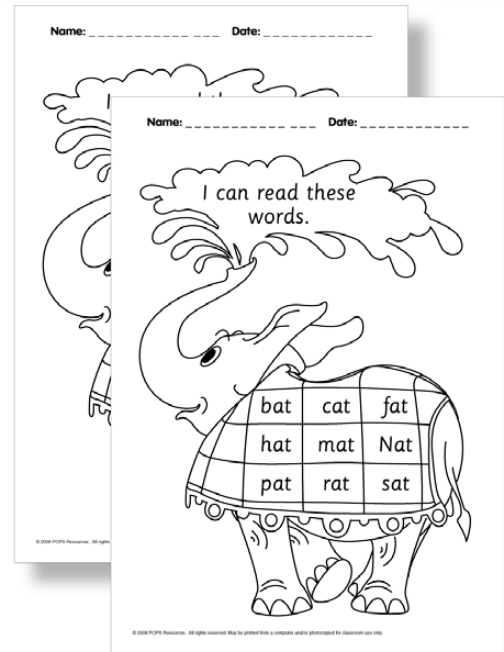


POPS Phonic Families: Stage 1

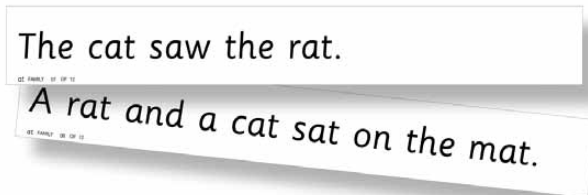

Word Family Indicator

(actual card size 175mm x 100mm)

To convey meaning, each family word is shown in context in a simple sentence. Your child can match the accompanying **Word Card** to the sentence, the picture or the large print of the word which appears in the **Large Word Cards** set.

Consolidation Sentences

(actual card size 240mm x 35mm)

The sentences use words from each word family to form simple sentences to consolidate learning. They also may be used to assess whether your child can read words in a word family without the support of picture clues. May also be used with supporting [Word Cards](#) for matching and naming games.

Combination Sentences

Ten men dance a jig with Dan and Jan.

an, at, en, ig 12 OF 12

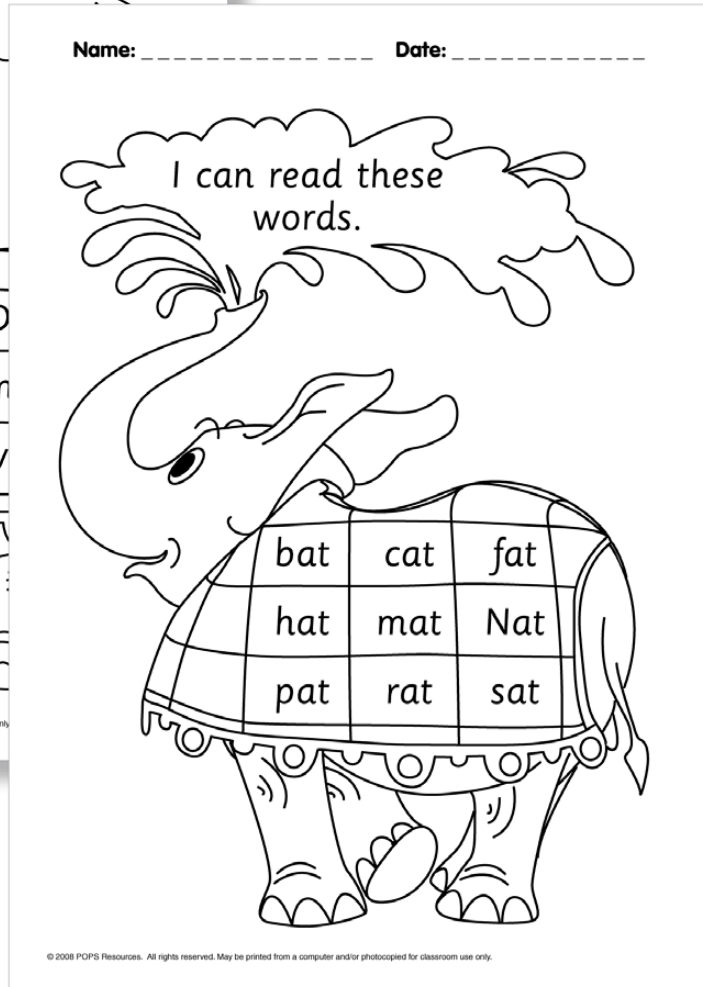
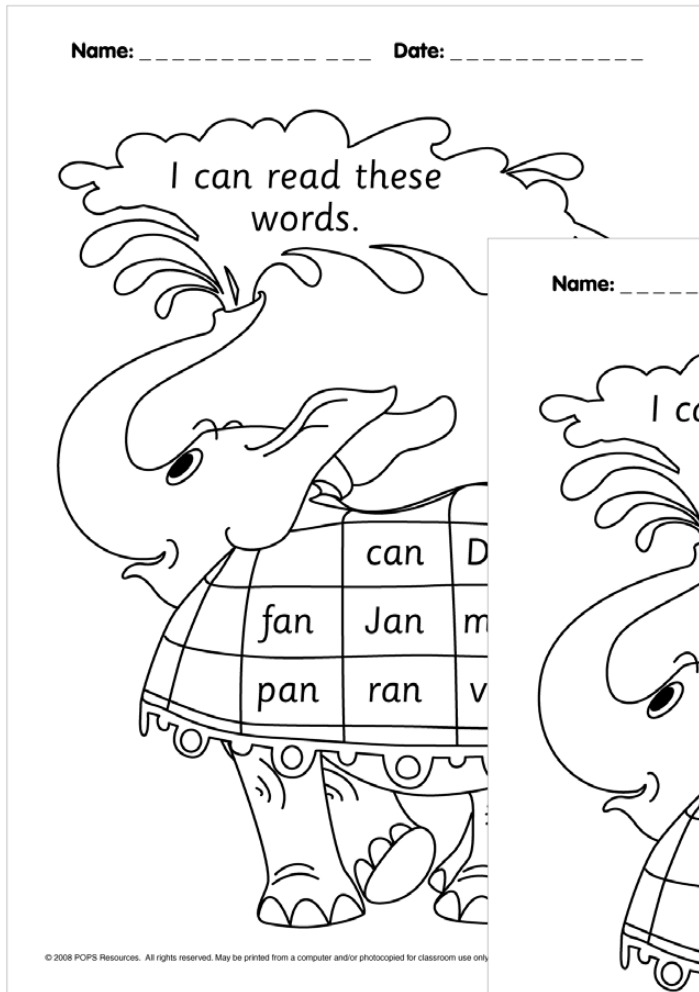
Ben and Dan put a wig and a pen on the mat.

Elephant Word Walls



(actual card size A4, 210mm x 297mm)

The **Elephant Word Walls** provide a visual reminder of what your child is working on. They can also be used as a quick continual assessment to make sure the words are retained. Every Word Family has an **Elephant Word Wall** with some blank spaces where your child may add words of high interest to him.
