Consolidation Sentences

Ben and the hen saw a pen.

Ten men ran to Ken.

Jen and Ben saw the den.

Ten men saw a hen in a den.

The cat saw the rat.

A rat and a cat sat on the mat.

(actual card size 240mm x 35mm)

The sentences use words from each word family to form simple sentences to consolidate learning. They also may be used to assess whether your child can read words in a word family without the support of picture clues. May also be used with supporting [Word Cards](#) for matching and naming games.

Combination Sentences

Ten men dance a jig with Dan and Jan.

The hen and the rat danced a jig on the mat.

The man saw a pan in a van.

A fat hen sat in the pan and ate a fig.

Pam and Jan ate a big fig on a mat in the den.

Ben and Dan put a wig and a pen on the mat.

(actual card size 240mm x 35mm)

These sentences combine words from all four word families in the pack to allow further opportunities for consolidation and assessment. May also be used with supporting [Word Cards](#) for matching and naming games.
